PURPOSE The Arc of New Mexico Higher Education Scholarship Fund was established in 2020 to assist recipients to achieve higher education training in Special Services or Occupational Training programs in New Mexico. The goal of the Arc of NM Higher Education Scholarship is to provide financial support for students with disabilities who seek to maximize their education and career opportunities.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on financial need. Scholarship awards are not intended to cover the entire cost of a college program. Scholarship awards are designated as "tuition only" and will be paid directly to the recipient's New Mexico school of choice upon verification of acceptance. There may be several scholarship awards in any given year depending on the number of applicants and the amount of money available.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Arc of NM's Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors are responsible for selecting scholarship recipients from all eligible applicants on an objective and non-discriminatory basis, without regard to sex, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability. The Arc of NM Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors shall select Arc of NM Higher Education Scholarship recipient(s).

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be a New Mexico resident.
- Applicants must be accepted or enrolled in a New Mexico Special Services or Occupational Training program.
- Applicants must demonstrate a need for financial assistance.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form;
- A personal statement, essay, or video that includes but is not limited to: an introduction of yourself, a
 description of your goals, your motivation, and the reasons why you want to attend college;
- One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, therapist, and/or administrator.
- OPTIONAL: Any other material(s), which applicant considers relevant.
- The entire application packet must be submitted to The Arc of NM office on or before the application deadline
